Course Descriptions Math 1 is the 9th grade Mathematics Course for the new Georgia Performance Standards. You will take Math 1 and the Support class all year and you will alternate classes every day. The support class is designed to preview new material and review material learned in Math 1.

Notebook and Supplies You are expected to keep a notebook for the class. You will keep notes, class handouts, and returned work. The last divider in your notebook should be labeled "Support". You are expected to bring your **textbook, pencil, and paper** to class everyday. You should also consider purchasing a **TI-84 or TI-83**.
